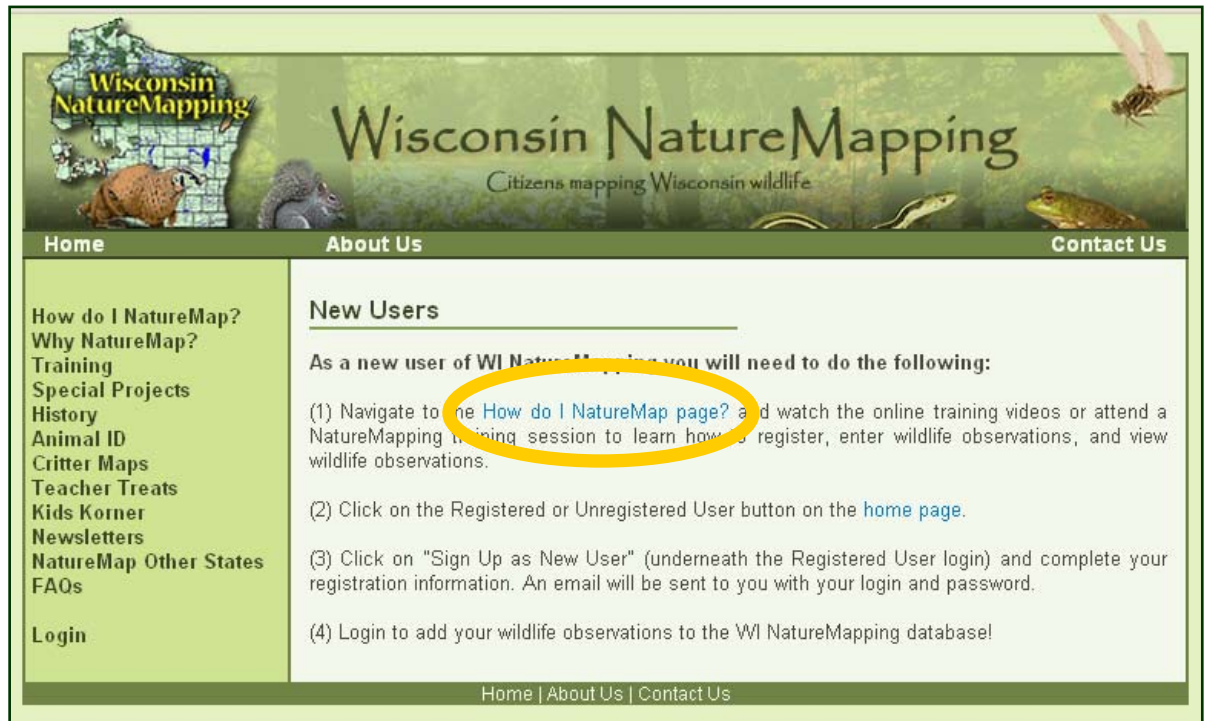


Follow these steps to become a registered NatureMapper. (If you have already watched all the NatureMapping Training Videos on the NatureMapping Website, skip to step 5.)

1) Go to the Wisconsin NatureMapping Homepage at [www.wisnatmap.org](http://www.wisnatmap.org) and click on the New User button.



2) This will bring you to the following page. Click on the **How do I NatureMap page?** link.



3) To become a NatureMapper without having to attend a training session at Beaver Creek Reserve or a NatureMapping Training click on the **online training videos** link.


